Vallis Trade Assurance Services (VTAS) acts as Independent Surveyors to supervise the loading of WHO pharmaceutical goods in Djibouti destined for Yemen.

VTAS staff survey the cargo onto various aircraft and vessels at the Djibouti – Ambouli International Airport and the PAID Seaport, Republic of Djibouti.
